AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SUBSECTION 2 OF SECTION 115.030 OF THE VILLAGE CODE PROVIDING FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES

ORDINANCE NO 707

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF UPLANDS PARK, COUNTY OF SAINT LOUIS, STATE OF MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.

Subsection 2 of Section 115.030 of the Village Code is repealed, amended and reenacted to read as follows:

2. Police Department:

a. Except as otherwise provided by ordinance or contract:

(1) 911 or emergency calls for enforcement of violations of the criminal laws of the state, including felonies, misdemeanors and infractions, within the village shall be directed to the Superintendent or Department of Police of the county of St Louis in the performance of duties vested and mandated by state law in the office of county sheriff and constable and as provided by Article IV, Section 4.275 of the Charter of the County of St. Louis.

(2) Enforcement of violations of the ordinances of the village shall be provided by the Village Marshal, Deputy Marshals and peace or police officers as provided by Chapters 71 and 80, Section 547.350, RSMo, and such other laws of the state and ordinances of the village as shall set forth rights, powers, privileges and duties of town and village Marshals and peace officers.

(3) The Village Marshal, Deputy Marshals and peace or police officers employed by the village shall also enforce state law violations committed or attempted to be committed in their presence and to provide such assistance to the St Louis County police as may be required in the
